

Cat Care Description

Reports to: Volunteer Coordinator, Kennel Technicians, Vet Tech Assistants

Time Commitment and Location of Work:

- MHS adoption floor
- Minimum 1 shift per week
- Shift from: 8am - 11am, 3pm - 7pm

Goals:

- Provide necessary daily care for the cats on the adoption floor
- Conduct positive interactions to increase cat confidence with strangers

Responsibilities:

- Sanitize cat kennels
- Prep empty kennels
- Replenish food (AM shift only)
- Refill waters (Both AM & PM)
- Clean litter boxes (AM shift only)
- Replace blankets as necessary
- Give enrichment/toys
- Facilitate positive interactions with all cats
- Take cats to the Meet & Greet rooms for socializing
- Spend time with cats who might have a harder time getting adopted
- Utilize green sheets to record medical/behavioral observations

Required Trainings:

- Completion of Cat Care Training

Qualifications:

- Comfortable handling cats of all personalities
- Ability to work independently without a staff member present
- Ability to lift 50 pounds, stoop, bend, and kneel
- Willingness and ability to follow specific instructions from staff
- Commitment to Midlands Humane Society practices, policies, and philosophy
